RELEASE OF TRANSCRIPTS FOR JUVENILE COURT PROCEEDINGS COUNTY OF KINGS

PURSUANT TO WELFARE AND INSTITUTIONS CODE SECTION 827

The Juvenile Court finds that:

In response to requests for copies of transcripts for juvenile court proceedings by individuals authorized to inspect and receive copies of a juvenile case file pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 827, subdivisions (a)(1) and (5), the court orders as follows:

- 1. Copies of transcripts will be provided based upon a request indicating that the requesting party is an individual authorized to inspect and receive copies of a juvenile case file. (Welf. & Inst. Code § 827, subd. (a)(1) and (5).)
- 2. Any individual receiving a copy of any transcript provided pursuant to this Order is prohibited from disseminating the transcript, any portion thereof, or information relating to the transcript to any person or agency, other than a person or agency authorized to receive documents pursuant to section 827. (Welf. & Inst. Code § 827, subd. (a)(4).)
- 3. Any dissemination or release to the public of the transcript, any portion thereof, or information relating to the transcript, including, but not limited to, filing such information in any other court proceeding, is prohibited absent further order of this court. Requests to disseminate or release will only be considered upon a duly noticed petition to the juvenile court. (See Welf. & Inst. Code § 827, subd. (a)(2)(A).)
- 4. This Order shall remain in effect until amended or terminated by order of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of California, Courty of Kings.
